


## How to purchase a Personal Use Timber Permit

Now that you have created a Manitoba elicensing Customer account, you can purchase items from [Manitoba elicensing](#).

Prior to purchasing your Personal Use Timber Permit, go to the [Forestry Branch website](#), Permits tab, to review information about volume, pricing, maps, and terms and conditions. **Choose the volume and area carefully; there are no refunds, exchanges or extensions of Personal Use Timber Permits.**

1. To purchase a Personal Use Timber Permit select “[Purchase Licence](#)” from the menu options at the top of the screen. In order to successfully complete a transaction through Manitoba elicensing, you are required to have an active Visa or MasterCard. Visa debit is not available as a payment option.

Additionally, you are required to have a printer to print any licences you purchase.

### Select Residency

**RESIDENT (HUNTING/TRAPPING/FORESTRY):**

- A Canadian citizen who has his/her home and is ordinarily present in the province immediately preceding the time that he/she purchases a licence, or
- A person who is not a Canadian citizen but has his/her home and is ordinarily present in the province for a period of six months immediately preceding the time that he/she purchases a licence, but does not include a tourist, transient or visitor.

**NON-RESIDENT (HUNTING/FORESTRY):**

- A person who is a Canadian citizen but is not a Manitoba resident.

**FOREIGN RESIDENT (HUNTING/FORESTRY):**

- A person who is neither a Canadian citizen nor a resident of Manitoba.

**RESIDENT (ANGLING):**

- A resident is a person who has lived Manitoba for the immediate past six months.
- Any youth under the age of 16 who has permanently resided in Manitoba for at least six months does NOT require a licence. Please refer to the Manitoba Anglers' Guide for more information.

**CANADIAN RESIDENT (ANGLING):**

- A Canadian resident is a person who has lived elsewhere in Canada for the immediate past six months.
- A Canadian resident youth under the age of 16 does not require an angling licence, but must fish with a licence holder or someone exempt from holding a licence and their catch must be applied to the limit of that person holding the licence. A youth under 16 who wishes to have their own separate limit must purchase their own angling licence. Please refer to the Manitoba Anglers' Guide for more information.

**NON-RESIDENT (ANGLING):**

- Any person who has not lived in Manitoba or Canada for the immediate past six months is a non-resident and must purchase a non-resident licence.
- A non-resident youth under the age of 16 does not require an angling licence, but must fish with a licence holder or someone exempt from holding a licence and their catch must be applied to the limit of that person holding the licence. A youth under 16 who wishes to have their own separate limit must purchase their own angling licence. Please refer to the Manitoba Anglers' Guide for more information.

## How to purchase a Personal Use Timber Permit

3. After clicking on “Proceed”, select the type of Personal Use Timber Permit you would like to purchase. If you are selecting a Treaty/Metis permit, you will see the Answer Additional Questions page. From the drop down under Recognized Status\* make the appropriate selection, a box will then open where the Treaty or Metis number can be entered. The Attest button may be selected. If Attest is selected the onus is on you to provide the Treaty or Metis information if requested by an Officer.



**PT1-Personal Use Timber** – Eastern Region Now you need to fill the “Timber Harvest Information”. On this screen you will find a pdf of all the Designated Cutting Areas in the Eastern Region. You can “View” or “Download” by clicking on the link.

**PT2-Personal Use Timber** –Western/Northwest/Northeast/Central Regions There are no established Designated Cutting Areas in the Western/Northwest/Northeast/Central Regions, therefore the process is different for those areas.

In the Western Region, harvest is permitted, under the authority of a Personal Use Timber Permit, on unoccupied Crown Land coloured light green, dark green or light brown on the maps. Avoid private land, First Nation Reserves, Treaty Land Entitlement areas, Ecological Reserves, regenerating and planted areas, etc. The onus is on you to harvest on unoccupied Crown land. Contact Conservation and Climate Regional or District offices for more information. See list below.

Western Region Maps can be viewed on the [Forestry Branch website](#). When purchasing your Personal Use Timber Permit for the Western Region, select the area you want from the drop down list. The map will print with your permit.

**Northwest/Northeast/Central Regions** - Harvest permitted, under the authority of a Personal Use Timber Permit, on unoccupied Crown Land. Avoid private land, First Nation Reserves, Treaty Land Entitlement areas, Ecological Reserves, regenerating and planted areas, etc. The onus is on you to harvest on unoccupied Crown land. 



The table describes the tree species available, the products this wood is suitable for, the condition of the wood, green (live) or dead and the season of access for the block. Check the area carefully to make sure it is what you want. There are no refunds, exchanges or extensions for personal use timber permits.







<b>Conditions of Permit</b> 1. No live timber shall be cut within 150 metres of any Provincial Highway or any other Government Road unless the timber is marked or otherwise designated for removal by a Conservation Officer. 2. Brush and logging debris shall be cut, lopped, and spread so as to lie close to the ground. Brush and logging debris on landings must be spread. Brush disposal must at all times keep pace with the cutting operations. Stumps shall not be cut higher than 30 centimetres from the highest point of adjacent ground. 3. The permittee must in no way interfere with any fencing or other improvements on this land. No live timber shall be cut within 150 metres of any building unless marked or otherwise designated for removal by a Conservation Officer. 4. Cutting of Elm for fuel wood is prohibited. 5. Avoid damage to regeneration and/or planted areas. 6. The use of heavy equipment (e.g. Skidders, Tractors) is prohibited unless authorized with a separate work permit obtained from a District Office before harvest occurs. 7. No extensions past expiry date and no refunds on personal use timber permits after purchase. 8. Maximum volume 25m <sup>3</sup> per permit. 9. In the Eastern Region the harvest of White Birch is limited to 5m <sup>3</sup> annually.	<b>Conditions de permis</b> 1. 

The third page of your permit is the Designated Cutting Area Map.


